3. Subcommittee Restructure Discussion/Breakout - Jennifer Price, Shane Libby & Janice LeRoux
 - o Why restructure?
 - o Attendance low – impacts activity & productivity
 - o Consolidation of subcommittees into 1 large subcommittee (unnamed at this time)
 - o WET Committee will remain separate and intact
 - o Propose subcommittees meet on same day as CCW Large meeting but start one hour earlier (9am – 10am, 4th Friday of month)
 - o Feedback from members in attendance – lengthy discussion ensued regarding the possibility of losing members when changing days & times.
 - o Attendee suggestion to move CCW Large meetings to another day of the week
 - o Reminder by other attendees that careful consideration and extensive research was given prior to setting the Friday meeting day & time
 - o Discussion re: difficulty in lengthening meeting time from 9am – 12pm
 - o **After much discussion: Plan to go forward as follows:**
 - o WET Committee to meet this coming Monday, February 26, 2018 – will discuss pros & cons of subcommittee meetings prior to Large meetings and report to Leadership Team
 - o Pilot Schedule Change – will try subcommittee meetings held prior to CCW Large meeting; from 10am – 11am. With Large Meeting business discussed from 11am – 12pm on 4th Friday of each month
 - o Will discuss positive & negative outcomes relative to subcommittee meeting time changes at May CCW Large Meeting (05.25.18)

5. MHSA 3 year planning Jennifer Cook
 - Brief overview given – next integrated plan due to be in place on July 1, 2020
 - Planning needs to start soon!
 - Possible Reversion of Funds:
 - Placer County has approximately \$136,000 of “Innovation” funds this year that may be subject to reversion
 - Goal – to avoid reversion of funds by designating these funds to a current, already approved project.
 - Adding funds to existing project would not affect project other than extending the time the project would/could be funded for.
