Training Calendar Update	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• MI basic and advanced in May• Adding Ben’s clinical supervision training, asked to combine an additional law and ethics training for cost purposes, he wanted to add another day to it, maybe Saturday, that doesn’t really work for people.• Law and Ethics – no training requested <p>In November 2019 - we have a Law and Ethics training with Ben for licensees and a Law and Ethics test prep (2 days) – Still negotiating</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Poverty Simulation on March 22nd<ul style="list-style-type: none">- 9am to 12pm. 15 volunteers needed		

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<p>Training Calendar Update (continued)</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Cultural competency – 6 webinars (2hrs each) will run over the next couple of months at different times<ul style="list-style-type: none">- After this training block, we will see how many people we have trained-reports on quarterly basis• CAHW – Eating Disorder, trainings in the 2 next month• Beverly Kyer is tentative, earliest she can do is august and September (later that what we wanted). Venue is pending.• Roberto called Jamie, he still wants 15000 for training. He will allow the training to be recorded for future use<ul style="list-style-type: none">- Staff going back and forth between Beverly and Roberto- Management wanted Beverly because her price is cheaper, but Roberto’s training is more robust in the components, he can train a large group of people at once, it would only be a few hours. He proposed a second training for employees that interact more often with clients, and a third session of a more leadership approach.- The 15000 does not include airfare, hotel, food, etc. BUT if we really could not make that happen, he is willing to include that in the 15000- Reuse a recorded training is valuable- This is Roberto’s expertise. We would have to ask Beverly to tailor somethings to meet our goals		
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	<ul style="list-style-type: none">- We need to talk to leadership before we continue negotiating with him. We need to run it by CCW and ASOC- Jamie will notify leadership that WET is interested- We believe we can afford it but the system need to think about the different agendas that we have for training- Even if we can get a venue for 2000 people, someone needs to be available to help the clients. We could have several sessions, morning and afternoon session. We don't know if that would cost us more. Record the first session, have people that didn't attend watch the recording. Possible webcast?- Who would pay the videography? What venues have recording abilities? Sierra college theater is a possibility- Will Beverly let us record?- Beverly will let us know if there are any cancellations do we can do the training this fiscal year- Maybe schedule Roberto for next spring • The clinical supervision will be April 18th<ul style="list-style-type: none">- Renewing clinicians will be 6 hrs- New licensees will attend 2 days • Hearing Voices training. CEO approval is required in order to send people out of state for training. • Possibilities of MHSA Regional training, ask other counties if they would be interested<ul style="list-style-type: none">- Location: maybe Tahoe
