- Meeting started at 1:12pm, with committee going over meeting minutes from last session
  - Motion to Approve-Cindy, second by Stacy- then committee realize the notes were not current- Michelle reviewed and stated that some notes were correct and some we not
  - Stacy- wants to approve both notes in January Meeting
  - Bring updated notes
- Motivational Interview next Thursday, 6<sup>th</sup>/7<sup>th</sup> – Dec 1<sup>st</sup> was not correct date
- Cultural competence- action item
  - Indigenous psychology to bring trainer back for small breakfast sessions (per Jamie)
  - Jamie mentioned implicit bias training
- Gina working on Poverty 101, Michelle has new contact and will follow up on that
- Referring back to Cultural competency training:
  - \$15,000 for 5 sessions
  - All inclusive, travel costs plus hotel
  - 40 people for ½ day
  - Committee would like more info of what the \$15,000 includes
  - Michelle will connect with Gina about training
  - Thoughts on brining Carlos in
  - Stacy will talk to Ana
  - Michelle suggested Beverly Kiar- asked if she was a sub or facilitated other trainings
  - Last cultural competency/linguistic training committee did not know what they needed, just needed to fill need of getting this type of training
  - Michelle suggests cultural humility training
  - Trainer Roberto engaging but focus is primarily on Latino culture
  - Chantelle suggests strategies 2.0 –committee is asking to see cultural competency binder KF staff received during their training
  - Committee starts brainstorming on who can train Beverly
  - Thoughts that Jamie may check in to it to get updated on what trainings are out there
- Cal Health/Wellness
  - Chris/Jamie have talked about this topic, looking good but committee is unaware of the implementation, but there is discussion
  - Looking for system wide, baseline training
  - There was follow up and the project is moving forward
- Bridges out of Poverty
  - Really want poverty simulation training
  - This may be more thought provoking/impactful
- Funding Requests
  - No info on funding, talk to Cathy per Cindy

- Amy/ Cathy does not do EMDR services- per Cindy
  - Why isn't county covering these services?
  - County does not provide service, but question is why are lights being requested if it is not a service county provides?
  - Pull EMDR request off of minutes, it is an inappropriate request for committee- motion has been denied
- PCN
    - CCW meeting next Friday, intro to implicit bias training brings, then full day training in January 2019
    - PCN is asking committee to cover some of the funding- training/ food for joint meeting
    - Leadership team has been approved for \$5,000. Full \$5,000 will not be used it is for a cushion
    - Michelle moves to approve it, all in favor-motion passed
- Consumer Council
    - Cindy- Table event, lunch went through, good event with lots of people.
    - Brought up 7 consumers and 2 parents
- Gift Card Budget
    - Committee was unsure if there was a budget for gift card/gas card
    - Increased for next meeting
    - People at Cirby have to travel
    - Needs to have a written request
    - Cindy will ask Jamie to have Cathy write for the record of the request
    - 9 additional consumers per year
    - Stacy can note online vote
    - Cindy asked committee if Jamie had sent out application
    - Catrina sent application right after last meeting
    - Cindy will have emailed re-forwarded to stacy/Jennifer
