COVID-19 Placer County Impact Updates: Amy Ellis & Twylla Abrahamson

- Placer County Health Officer Dr. Aimee Sisson resigned; Dr. Rob Oldham (New HHS Director) will stand in until Public Health Officer roll is filled
- Board of Supervisors passed resolution declaring Placer County is no longer in a state of emergency
  - Number of Placer County COVID cases holding steady
  - Continue with safety protocols – meet County needs in a safe way
  - Schools opening – impact to families
- Impact to County services
  - Not much change at County level
  - Navigating changes with workforce, productivity, staff needs
  - Telecommuting services going well; offering face to face when necessary
- Influenza season – get flu shots to avoid a “twin-demic”
  - Accessibility for adults, children, and seniors
  - Clinics at schools and churches (info listed CCW and PCN)
- Support local businesses safely; help economy and keep people safe
