Nicole “Nikki” Fernandez – was interim program director. Megan coming back mid-August and promoting; Nicole remaining program manager for The Gathering Inn

County Updates, CalAIM, Housing Updates

Amy – program director ASOC

- Moving forward with Adult Crisis Respite Center at Cirby Hills (6-8 beds)
 - Renovation begins soon; complete by end of year or late January
 - Innovation Plan timeline to coordinate with program start upon renovation completion
- Funding opportunities
 - \$700k for renovations for first round of home-key at Brown Bear Studios in the Tahoe region if approved by board
 - More programming space, utilization for residents in facility
 - Anticipate additional Home-key 2.0 funding for more housing projects
 - Treatment money for more infrastructure for MH/SUS services
- Invite input on ideas to fill gaps in services

Twylla – CSOC director

- Funding coming to communities from Federal Government American Rescue
- Number of funding streams for youth mental health needs in schools
- FFPSA – Families First Prevention Services Act
 - California opting in; roll out October 1st
 - Evidence based programs that will be eligible for these funds.

- Amy reports that CalAIM impacts Mental Health Plans
 - Affects documentation practices, timelines, what we can and cannot bill for
 - Streamline/ improve process; Access to Mental Health Services
- Enhanced Care Management and In Lieu of Services (ECM and/or ILOS)
 - Managed Care Plan responsibility to roll our new medical billable service

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- Will roll out in phases – Identify providers; Find gaps in services; target SMI, substance use, homeless; target other vulnerable populations
- Reaching out to community to be potential providers for these services.

Jennifer Price – Housing Updates

- Eviction Moratorium on Evictions thru September 30th
- Changes in the state’s Emergency Rental Assistance Program
 - State will pay 100% back rent, instead of previous 80% back rent
 - Apply at housingiskey.com
 - Application process simplified
- Special court process for evictions starting October 1st

Placer County Office of Education (PCOE) – School Program & Funding Updates

Mike Lombardo; Ali Murphy

- All updates subject to change!
- All Placer County schools in person for 21/22 school year
 - Distance learning discontinued in June 2021
 - AB130 – every school in California will offer independent study; rules have changed and are similar to “distance learning”
 - As of last week, children and adults must wear face covering (regardless of vaccination)
 - Districts and schools can make their own guidelines on non-compliance
- MONEY
 - Community Schools
 - \$3 billion one-time funds to 1000-1600 schools in CA (out of 10K schools)
 - Wellness center model
 - Student Mental Health
 - \$400 million one-time mix of federal and general fund
 - Increase Access
 - \$525 million one-time general fund grant programs
 - Improve schools’ ability to bill Medi-cal
- Placer Project – new response to student trauma
 - Kognito – Trauma Informed Educator
 - Launched web-based learning system for educators to become trauma informed
 - Handle with Care – adverse event notification
- Continue School Services
 - Suicide Prevention trainings – ASSIST, Safe Talk, Mental Health First Aid, Youth Mental Health First Aid

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Ali Murphy – Wellness Program

- Partnered with PCOE and CSOC to create on-campus services
- Focused on integrated school mental health and 4 As – Accessibility, availability, affordability, and acceptability
- Multi-tier system of support – prevention, small groups, individual case management
- Early data for 2019-20 presented (available on recording)

Speaker's Bureau Lived Experience Speaker: Tandy

Janelle Brancato –AMIH, partnered with Placer County's ASOC

Tandy – Shared Lived Experience

- Mental illness, homelessness, and substance disorders survivor
- Reached out for help and followed doctor's orders to recover
- Doctor suggested sober living environment (AB109)
- Network with area client to get info on available resources (Summer 2018)
- Progressive experience with AMI – relationships restored, permanent housing, no police contact

 - Strength in Communities
 - [BIPOC Mental Health Toolkit](#)
- MHSA FY21-22 Annual Update & Proposed 2021-2026 Innovation Plan – APPROVED
 - Submitting Innovation Plan for State Review
 - Need final approval before funds can be made available
 - Hope to make calendar by early fall

 - New system launched with our service providers that receive MHSA services
