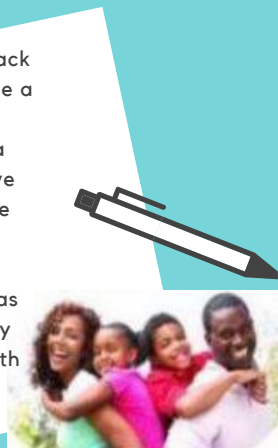




## BLACK MINDS MATTER 2!
