<p>New Training Ideas</p>	<p>Priority Populations (CCW) (Native American; Latino; LGBTQI; Older Adults; Transition Age Youth (TAY))</p> <p>START:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Diane Lucas discussed START Assessment Tool – Short Term Assessment of Risk and Treatability <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Placer County received a grant for jail diversion that requires risk assessment tool before release ○ START is 1 page assessment tool designed to evaluate individuals with mental illness, substance abuse and/or those involved with criminal justice system ○ Assess short term risk for outer population for release into the community and begin case planning for treatment in the community; builds on clients' strengths ○ Training is 14 hours with CE credit ○ Training is expensive, but group rates are available (\$375 for individuals; \$3000 rate for 10 people; \$9000 rate for 30 people) ○ No local training available; currently trained through the state. ○ START trainees have free access to scoring sheet to quickly assess risk
