

Clinical Supervision: Nine-hour Supplement for New Supervisors

Training Overview

Placer County Systems of Care, in collaboration with the Campaign for Community Wellness, is pleased to offer this nine (9) hour instructor-led Clinical Supervision Training for professionals licensed with the California Board of Behavioral Sciences. This 9-hour remote training is designed to supplement the 6-hour recorded webinar offered through Simple Practice Learning to complete the fifteen (15) training hours required for new clinical supervisors. This training will prepare supervisors for the full scope of current supervisor responsibilities. Topics include updated requirements for clinical supervisors, supervision contracts, the nature of the supervision relationship and strategies to be an effective supervisor, how to differentiate between appropriate and inappropriate self-disclosure, elements of documentation, and distinct supervisory roles. This course combined with the recorded 6-hour webinar fulfills the requirement for new clinical supervisors to provide individual and group supervision to associates and trainees collecting hours for licensure as an LPCC, LMFT, and/or LCSW.

Learning Objectives

Nine (9) hour segment (three 3-hour modules):

- Describe at least 5 changes in requirements for supervisors of California master's level clinicians that took effect January 1, 2022;
- List at least 4 key components of a supervision contract;
- Apply at least 3 supervision activities designed to build and support the supervisory relationship, and 2 supervision activities designed to help supervisees become more clinically effective;
- Sort at least 4 types of supervisor self-disclosure into types that are generally appropriate for supervision and generally inappropriate for supervision;
- Identify at least 4 common elements of documentation of supervision; and
- Differentiate between 4 distinct supervisor roles.

Continue Education

This nine (9) hour training component is designed to supplement a six (6) hour webinar offered through Simple Practice Learning. This 9-hour supplement meets the qualifications for 9 of the 15 hours required for new supervisors; continuing education credit for MFTs, LPCCs, LEPs, and/or LCSWs as required by the California Board of Behavioral Sciences. Placer County Systems of Care, CAMFT-approved Continuing Education Provider #041035, maintains responsibility for this course and its content.

About the Instructor

Dr. Benjamin Caldwell is a California licensed marriage and family therapist and clinical supervisor. He is the author of five books, including *Basics of California Law for LMFTs, LPCCs, and LCSWs*, which is now on its fifth edition, and *Saving Psychotherapy*. He serves as adjunct faculty for California State University, Northridge and The Wright Institute in Berkeley, CA. In his role as Chair of the Legislative and Advocacy Committee for the California Division of AAMFT, he was directly involved in California's first-in-the-nation ban on reparative therapy for minors, and he drove the change in title from "intern" to "associate" for pre-licensed MFTs and PCCs. For his advocacy work, he was awarded the AAMFT Division Contribution Award in 2013. Ben maintains a private practice in Los Angeles specializing in working with couples.

Requirement/Target Audience

This course is for clinical professionals licensed with the BBS who are or intend to be clinical supervisors. Licensure must be held for a minimum of 2 years in addition to requirements outlined in §1821, §1833.1 and §1870 of the BBS Statutes and Regulations. In order to provide supervision to all BBS disciplines, the prospective supervisor must complete an initial 15-hour training and 6-hour training every renewal period thereafter. *Placer County Employees must get supervisor approval.*

Target Audience:

This training is intended for clinical professionals licensed with the California Board of Behavioral Sciences for a minimum of two years, in addition to meeting the criteria outlined in the BBS Statutes and Regulations.

- ◆ The six-hour Clinical Supervision Webinar is intended for renewing supervisors, and it also serves as six of the fifteen hours required for new supervisors.
- ◆ The nine-hour Clinical Supervision supplement is a live training for new supervisors to complete their required fifteen hours.

Schedule:

The six-hour webinar is offered through Simple Practice Learning. Users will be provided with a link to access the webinar through Simple Practice Learning at no charge. Users are encouraged to complete the 6-hour webinar prior to attending the remote 9-hour supplement to complete the 15-hours training requirement for new supervisors.

The nine-hour remote supplement to complete the required 15-hours for new supervisors consists of three, 3-hour training modules. All three modules are required to complete the 9-hour component of the training. A link to the remote training platform will be provided to registered participants prior to the training.

Registration for each of the remote training modules will begin 15 minutes prior to start of the training time listed on the flyer, and a 15 minute break will be offered at the trainer's discretion during each the remote 3-hour segments.

Course Certificates and CEUs

The six-hour webinar is offered through Simple Practice Learning. CEUs for the 6-hour webinar portion of this training are provided by Simple Practice Learning.

Attendance for the 9-hour supplement training will be closely monitored by an administrator. Participants are required to attend and participate for the duration of the training each day for credit. Attendees who complete the training attendance requirements will be able to view and print their Completion/CEU Certificate from the Transcripts tab in Placer Learns within two weeks of the training date. Please note the number of course credits does not include the time allotted for registering, taking lunch, or other breaks. Attendees not present and accounted for will not receive credit. Partial credit is not offered.
