## How is this program different from other intensive services like Wraparound?

Children in programs such as Wraparound typically have had numerous services and have significant mental health issues. The majority are stepping down from out-of-home care and are considered to need the highest level of treatment.

The goal of Home to Stay is to provide intensive services over a short time to prevent the need for deeper-end services and to help families manage challenges in order to keep children in the home.

## Why Lilliput, a part of Wayfinder Family Services?

At Lilliput, we know that parenting a child with emotional or behavioral challenges can be overwhelming for even the most equipped parents. For relative caregivers, parenting can be even tougher as they must manage their own loss while at the same time trying to parent a child who is grieving or has a history of trauma.

When parents don't have the tools they need, they may find themselves triggered by their children's behavior, or become overly authoritative or permissive. We believe that all parents want what is best for their children and that all children deserve the chance to live in safe, loving and nurturing families. Our services are trauma-informed, attachment-focused and family centered.
