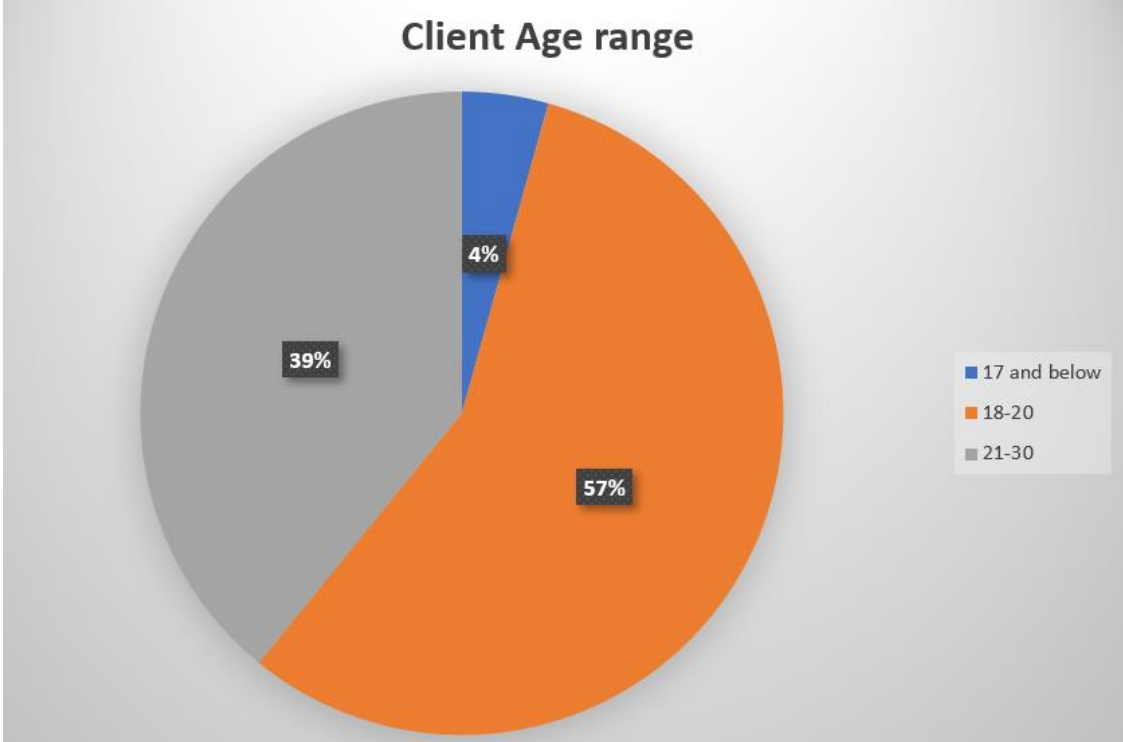

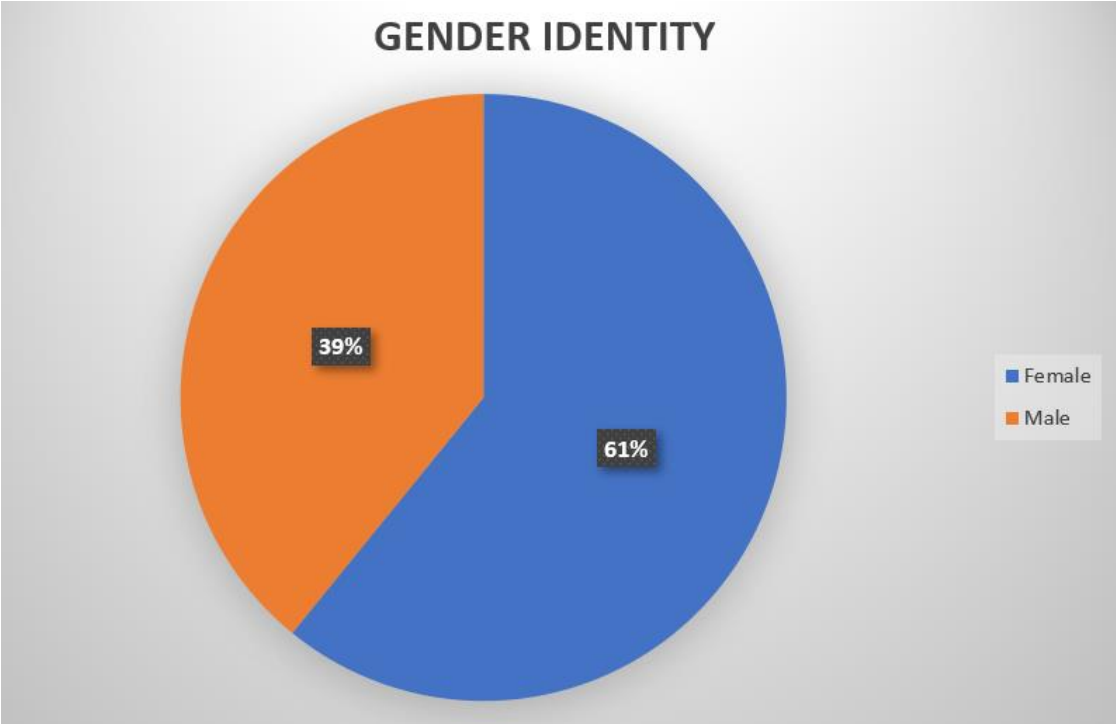
Demographics: Percentage by Age

Age of Clients Served : Percentage by Client Count



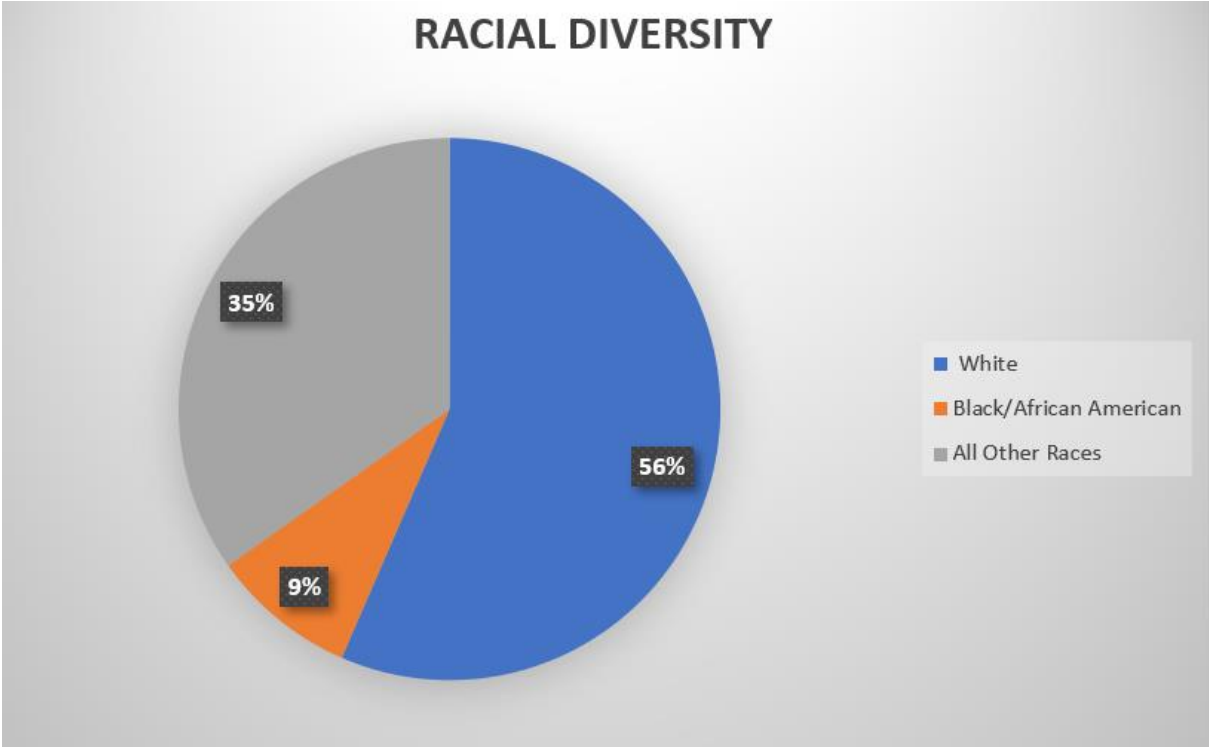
Demographics: Percentage by Gender Identity

Gender of Clients Served



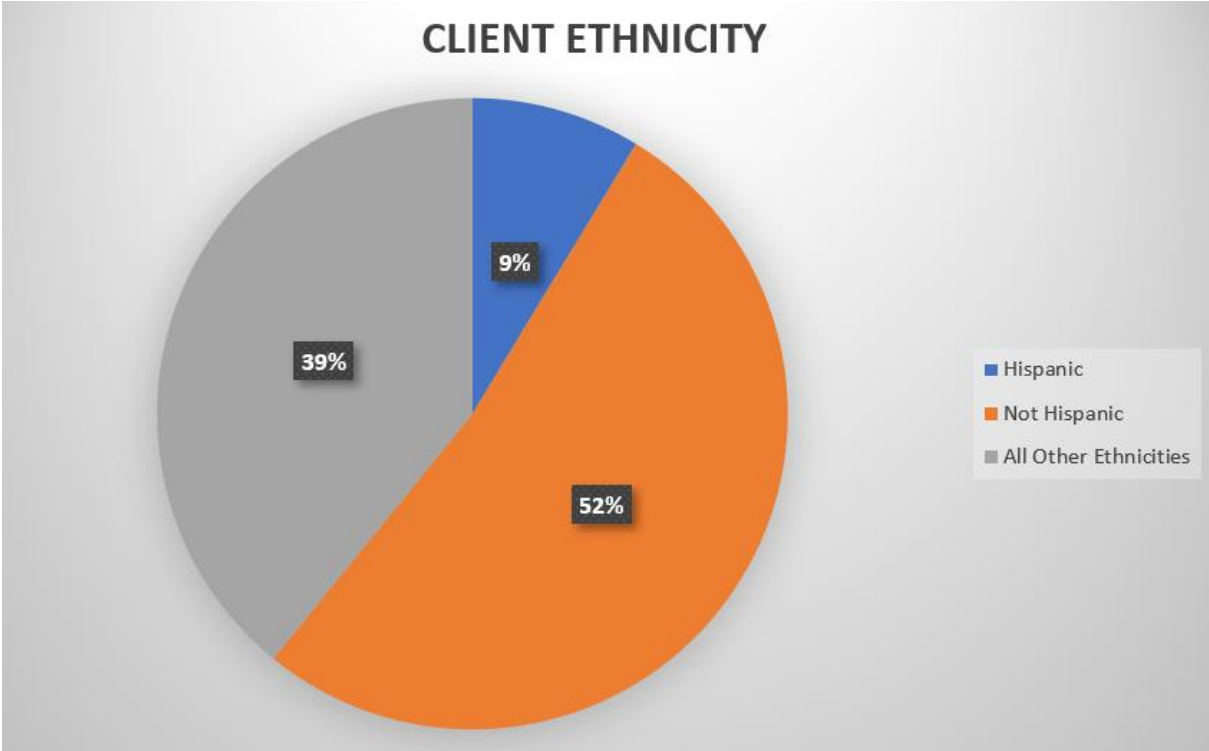
Demographics: Percentage by Client Race

Racial Diversity of Clients Served



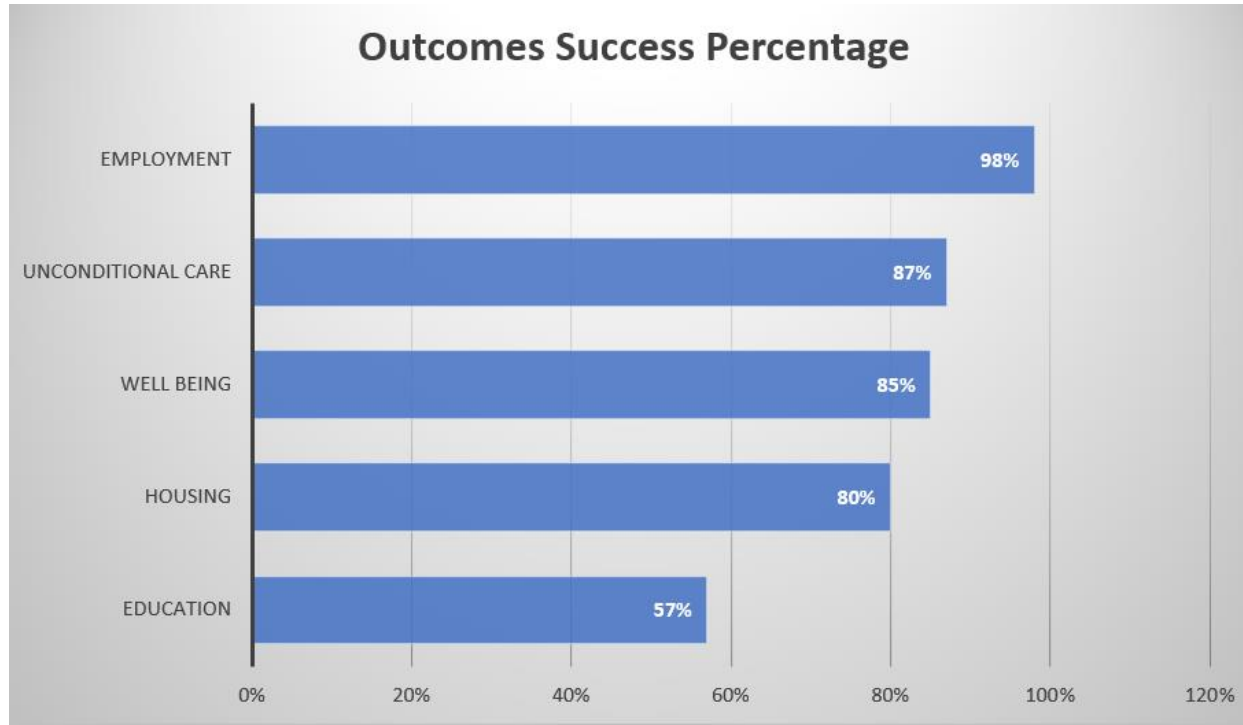
Demographics: Percentage by Ethnicity
