WHAT IS ASIST

ASIST is an interactive training that supports community members to feel more comfortable and competent in helping to prevent the immediate risk of suicide.

To maintain the fidelity of this training, we cannot permit more than 3-5 participants from the same organization/district in each training.

- Learn how to recognize suicide risk and assist a person at risk to "keep safe for now"
- Experience powerful videos on suicide intervention
- Feel challenged and safe
- See, hear, and learn the information and skills needed to provide suicide first aid

WHO SHOULD ATTEND

This course is appropriate for anyone 16 years and older who want to learn suicide intervention skills.
