

Clinical Supervision Training for New Supervisors—9 hours



Training Description

This Clinical Supervision training is a 9-hour remote training held over three half-days. It is designed to supplement a 6-hour recorded webinar offered through Ben Caldwell Labs to complete the fifteen (15) hours of training required for new clinical supervisors. This live training will prepare supervisors for the full scope of current supervisor responsibilities. Topics include remote (video-based) supervision, supervision models, the nature and dynamics of the supervision relationship, supervision exercises, and common supervisor questions.

Learning Objectives

Participants will be able to:

- Describe at least two changes in legal requirements for supervision that took effect in 2022
- Describe at least three dynamics that can impact the supervisory relationship
- Describe at least one tenet for each of at least three models of supervision
- List at least five responsibilities of supervisors
- Apply at least two exercises in individual supervision
- Apply at least two exercises in group supervision

About the Instructor

Dr. Benjamin Caldwell is a California licensed marriage and family therapist and clinical supervisor. He is the author of five books, including *Basics of California Law for LMFTs, LPCCs, and LCSWs*, which is now on its 10th edition, and *Saving Psychotherapy*. He serves as adjunct faculty for California State University, Northridge. In his past role as Chair of the Legislative and Advocacy Committee for the California Division of AAMFT, he was directly involved in California's first-in-the-nation ban on reparative therapy for minors, and he drove the change in title from "intern" to "associate" for pre-licensed MFTs and PCCs. For his advocacy work, he was awarded the AAMFT Division Contribution Award in 2013. Ben maintains a private practice in Los Angeles, specializing in working with couples.

Target Audience:

This course is for clinical professionals licensed with the BBS who are or intend to be clinical supervisors. Licensure must be held for a minimum of 2 years in addition to requirements outlined in §1821, §1833.1 and §1870 of the BBS Statutes and Regulations. In order to provide supervision to all BBS disciplines, the prospective supervisor must complete an initial 15-hour training and 6-hour training every renewal period thereafter. **Placer County Employees must get supervisor approval.**

Schedule:

This 9-hour remote training is designed to supplement the 6-hour recorded webinar offered through Ben Caldwell Labs to complete the fifteen (15) training hours required for new clinical supervisors.

1. Participants are encouraged to complete the 6-hour recorded webinar before attending the 9-hour supplement. Email PlacerLearns-SOCadmin@placer.ca.gov to request registration for the 6-hour recorded webinar through Ben Caldwell Labs .
2. The live 9-hour supplement consists of three remote 3-hour training modules over three half-days. Registered users will receive an email with a Zoom link to access the remote sessions prior to the training start date. Each training will open 15 minutes prior to the start of the training time listed on the flyer. This training will require participants to have access to a computer with webcam capabilities, audio, and reliable internet.

Continuing Education Credit and Course Certificates

CE hours for the 6-hour webinar portion of this training are provided by Ben Caldwell Labs.

Attendance for the 9-hour supplement training will be closely monitored by an administrator. Participants are required to attend and participate for the duration of the training each day for credit.
